Medication Policy required by DHS

Dear Parents,

As a reminder, any medication brought to the daycare must be accompanied by a completed DHS Medication Authorization Form (Montessori staff can get this to you). This form must be filled out before any medication can be administered at school. Unless you signed the Tylenol/ibuprofen waver in the registration packet when they started then we would be able to give the Tylenol/ Ibuprofen, we would also call you and let you know if we do.

Please follow these important guidelines when sending medication:

- All medicine must be age-appropriate and in its original packaging.
- Prescription medications must have the child's name clearly labeled on the bottle.
 - *Tip:* You can ask your doctor or pharmacy to label two bottles of the prescription—one to stay at home and one to keep at school.
- All medications must be within their expiration date.
- Do not mix medication into drinks unless the prescription label specifically states to do so.

These steps help us ensure the safety and well-being of all children in our care. If you have any questions, please feel free to speak with a staff member.
